- 1 short sleeve black leotard, 1 long sleeve black leotard, 1 black leotard of your choice
- 2 pairs of pink tights, 2 pairs of black tights, 1 pair of skin tone tights (convertible)

• Traditional ballet shoes (PINK)

• Skin tone leotard

Pens and pencils (bring a writing utensil to class every day.)

• Pointe shoes (for grades 9-12) (9th graders will receive a separate letter of instruction for purchasing the first pair of pointe shoes.)

Highlighters

- It is very helpful for the dancers to have their own dance bag to carry their belongings in.
- Always remember to keep your work from the previous year, we will reference the material often.

A combination lock for your dance locker.

- Please label all belongings with permanent marker on the inside of the garment/shoes.
- Male Dancers- White or black form fitting t-shirt, black form fitting shorts, black form fitting pants, black ballet shoes.

Please be reminded that, when purchasing your supplies:

• Do not purchase house slippers that look like traditional ballet slippers. Although they are cute and less expensive they do not serve the intended purpose.

• Please do not purchase leotards with skirts attached or any type of jewelry or

desígns.

• The purpose of the body stocking is to replace your undergarments. A body stocking is typically worn underneath your leotard and tights. It is also very beneficial under costuming. It provides a clean line and eliminates your undergarments. Please purchase a flesh colored body stocking.

• Just a reminder, attire is part of your grade and a deduction will be made if the proper attire is not worn, worn incorrectly or adhered to for every class,

rehearsal or performance.

• The purpose of a flesh-colored leotard works in tandem with the body stocking under costuming for quick changes and professional presentation on stage. Depending on the costume type either or both may be required.

What not to buy

• Please do not buy leotards with attached skirts, jewelry or designs, Pointe shoes unless worn in the previous year's class, warm-up clothing or extra accessories unless it is requested in writing from one of our faculty members.

Dancer's Survival Kit

We also require that each student should purchase the following items for your "Dancer's Survival Kit".
